<p style="text-align: center;"><b>For Math Class</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Spiral Notebook w/ pockets to hold worksheets for homework – this will be used daily by your student and will remain with them.</li> <li>- Pencils needed daily for class and homework.</li> <li>- 1” binder for math portfolio with name written on the spine This is kept in the math classroom. <b>(Not necessary for returning students who were in 4<sup>th</sup> grade at LECS)</b></li> <li>- 1 pack of white board markers</li> </ul> <p><b>Home Use Supplies:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Grid Paper <b>(student keeps)</b></li> <li>- Protractor <b>(student keeps for home use)</b></li> <li>- Ruler that measures inches and centimeters <b>(student keeps for home use)</b></li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>For Science and Social Studies</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3 – 3 prong with pocket folders. 1 blue, 1 yellow, 1 green (not plastic), please label with name on outside of each folder</li> <li>3 – marble composition books. Names on each, one labeled “Science Fair” , one and one labeled “Science”, and one labeled “Social Studies”</li> <li>1 – highlighter, red pen and blue pen <b>(for daily student use)</b></li> <li>1 – 2” solid BLUE binder (to be used as Science and SS portfolio) Please label with name on spine. <b>(If you are a returning 5<sup>th</sup> grader you already have this.)</b></li> <li>1 set of Earbuds <b>for personal use</b></li> <li>1 package pencils <b>for classroom</b></li> <li>1 - package of colored pencils - Incoming 5th graders <b>for classroom</b></li> <li>1 – package of markers – Incoming 4th graders <b>for classroom</b></li> <li>3 – glue sticks <b>for personal use</b></li> </ul>
