

Cluster III Supply List 2011-2012

For everyday use by students (not to be turned in to teacher):

- One 1-inch binder with 4 subject area pocketed dividers labeled for: Math, Reading, Writing, and Spelling
- Notebook paper for binder
- 5 Black-and-White Composition books – 1 for language arts, and 4 for science (one for science fair; one per trimester for class use)
- One 3-ring, two pocket folder with notebook paper for social studies
- Blue or black ink pens
- Mechanical pencils, lead, and erasers for math and science labs
- Protractor for math (for home use)
- A USB memory stick/flash drive
- Scientific calculator

To be handed in to your homeroom teacher for classroom use:

- 3 boxes of tissues
- 1 package of 24 (or more) blue or black ink pens
- 1 pack of 4 Low-Odor Dry-Erase Markers (preferably Expo Chisel Point)
- 1 pump bottle of hand sanitizer
- 2 Glue Sticks
- 1 package Crayola Markers
- 1 box of #2 pencils 24 count (or more)

6th-graders: 1 package of notebook paper

7th-graders: 1 roll of paper towels

8th-graders: 1 ream of copy/printer paper

Fees:

- \$1 to purchase environmentally safe cleaning products for classroom use (turn in to homeroom teacher)
- \$5.00 book fee for the purchase of literature for the classroom library (turn in to Ms. Friedman)

Spanish Class

- One 3-ring, two pocket folder with notebook paper. Students may choose the color or design; pockets are required
