

## Cluster III Supply List 2017-2018

### **For everyday use by students (not to be turned in to teacher):**

- One 1½ inch binder with 2 subject area pocketed dividers labeled for: Math and Social Studies
- One 1½ inch red binder for 8<sup>th</sup> grade HOPE students
- Notebook paper for binder
- 5 Black-and-White Composition books – 1 for language arts, and 4 for science (one for science fair; one per trimester for class use)
- Blue or black ink pens
- Small, handheld pencil sharpener with closed case to collect shavings
- Cap erasers for pencils
- Mechanical pencils, lead, and erasers for math and science labs
- A USB memory stick/flash drive (4GB or more)

### **Classroom Supplies (To be handed in to your homeroom teacher):**

- 3 boxes of tissues
- 1 package notebook paper
- 12 #2 pencils
- 1 pack of 2 Low-Odor Dry-Erase Markers (preferably Expo Chisel Point BLACK)
- 6<sup>th</sup>-graders: 1 large or 2 small glue sticks & 1 box of Band-Aids
- 7<sup>th</sup>-graders: 1 package Crayola Colored Markers (fat or thin tip) & 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 8<sup>th</sup>-graders: 1 ream of copy/printer paper & 1 package (10 or 12) blue or black ink pens

### **Fees:**

- \$1 to purchase environmentally safe cleaning products for classroom use (turn in to homeroom teacher)
- \$5.00 book fee for the purchase of literature for the classroom library (turn in to Ms. Friedman)

### **Spanish Class (to be handed in to the Spanish teacher):**

- One two-pocket folder of any color or design.
- Students from each grade are to donate the following to the Spanish classroom:
  - 6<sup>th</sup>-graders:** one pack of blue or black ink pens
  - 7<sup>th</sup>-graders:** one package of notebook paper
  - 8<sup>th</sup>-graders:** 12 #2 pencils (Only the following bulk brands, please: **Dixon, Ticonderoga, USA Gold, USA Silver**. Please do **not** purchase “HB” pencils or bulk pencils from Target, Walmart, or Office Depot)

### **P.E. Class (to be handed in to the P.E. teacher):**

- Students from each grade are to donate the following for use in P.E.:
  - 6<sup>th</sup>-graders:** non-latex gloves (one package)
  - 7<sup>th</sup>-graders:** Disinfectant wipes (one package)
  - 8<sup>th</sup>-graders:** 1 Instant Cold Pack

### **Portfolios (To be used for math, science, and social studies)**

**6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup>-graders:** Please purchase one extra set of 5 tab dividers for your social studies portfolio (it will need 10 dividers in all). You need 15 for Mr. Madewell’s class.

**Returning 8<sup>th</sup>-graders: Do not purchase new portfolios, unless your old ones need to be replaced. Purchase tab dividers for your portfolios if they need them.**

- 6<sup>th</sup>-graders:** Two 1 ½ inch White 3-ring binders with 12 tab dividers in each and one 2 ½-3 inch white binder with 15 tab dividers for Mr. Madewell’s science class.
- New 7<sup>th</sup>-graders:** Two 1 ½ inch Red 3-ring binders with 12 tab dividers in each and one 2 ½-3 inch white binder with 15 tab dividers for Mr. Madewell’s science class. You will be replacing the one you already have in science.
- New 8<sup>th</sup>-graders:** Three 1 ½ inch Blue 3-ring binders with 12 tab dividers in each. You need 15 tab dividers for science.
