

CLUSTER III HOMEWORK PROCEDURES

The homework schedule for Cluster III is as follows:

Math: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday nights.
Language Arts: 30 minutes reading per night, including weekends; writing as needed to meet deadlines.
Science: Tuesday and Thursday nights.
Social Studies: Wednesday nights.
Civics/Spanish/Health: Homework assigned will be due the following class period.

All teachers post their homework on the LECS website (www.lecs.org). You may check homework on-line, or have it automatically e-mailed to you (click on "Homework" and then follow the directions). Parents need to re-enroll to have homework e-mailed to them for the current school year.

Students are required to copy down their homework in their agendas. All unfinished classwork automatically becomes homework. Even if students are downloading assignments from the internet, they should be recording their homework in their agendas and using them to manage long-term assignments. Students are required to have their agendas with them every day.

All graded work and assignments are returned to students and are kept in their folder/notebooks until placed into their portfolios. Parents should check their child's folder/notebooks regularly to monitor his/her progress.

Consequences for Not Completing Required Classwork and Homework:

Any time a student does not turn in an assignment on time she/he will be given a "Note Home." It will be the student's responsibility to have it signed by parent/guardian and returned to the homeroom teacher the following day.

CLUSTER III RULES & CONSEQUENCES

Rules:

Weekly Consequences for Breaking Cluster Rules:

Level One: Verbal warning

Level Two: Any time a student reaches level two, she/he will be given a "Note Home." It will be the student's responsibility to have it signed by parent/guardian and returned to the homeroom teacher the following day. Any student who receives multiple Notes Home in one week advances to level 3 or 4.

Level Three: After-school detention

Level Four: Referral to office

Bullying and Disrespect: will not be tolerated. Any case will be referred immediately to the office.
